

Position Title: Contract Facilitator (Girls Group Program)

Summary

NSMS is seeking an experienced facilitator to plan and co-facilitate the Girls Group program (using art-based activities) for Grade 8-12's on a contract basis. Under the direction of the Youth Coordinator and the Program Manager, the Facilitator will be responsible for working closely with the Youth Coordinator to revise/deliver/facilitate, and evaluate the program. The program will consist of 3 Saturday sessions (Feb. 9, 16, 23, 2019) from 10am – 3:30pm at the North Shore Multicultural Society (NSMS).

Each day will include 8 working hours, including prep time, program time, clean up and dealing with any specific needs. There will be an additional 3 hours allocated for meeting time, for a total of 27 hours. The program will include art activities designed to foster confidence building, self-reflection and connection amongst participants, and support the integration process of immigrant girls.

Qualifications:

- Degree, diploma, or certificate in community development, youth leadership, counselling or education, and/or an appropriate combination of experience and training
- Although this program is not a therapy group, art therapy training/experience is an asset
- Good working knowledge of immigrant youth barriers and challenges, social justice issues, diversity and anti-racism
- Demonstrated ability to work with key stakeholders including the supervisor, NSMS colleagues, participants, parents, and funders
- Demonstrated ability to adapt to the learning needs of English language learners
- Second language (Farsi/Mandarin/Cantonese an asset)
- Experience and/or training in facilitation of youth groups, with experience in participatory action learning
- Excellent interpersonal-communication skills, experienced in conflict resolution
- Experience in finding methods to overcome immigrant youth barriers/problem solving
- Demonstrated experience in youth involvement strategies and models
- Experience in working with immigrant and refugee youth, specifically in the areas of settlement
- Experience in one-on-one youth support an asset
