North Shore Language Centre is a partnership program between MOSAIC and North Shore Multicultural Society. English language students attend classes at the Immigrant Service Centre that is a “hub” model where clients can access a variety of programs and services that meet their settlement needs in one building. In addition to language services, clients can access employment services through Work BC, settlement services through NSMS settlement workers, meet family needs through Settlement Workers and the SWIS program, find network building opportunities through Community Connections and the Get Connected program, and access youth engagement programs.

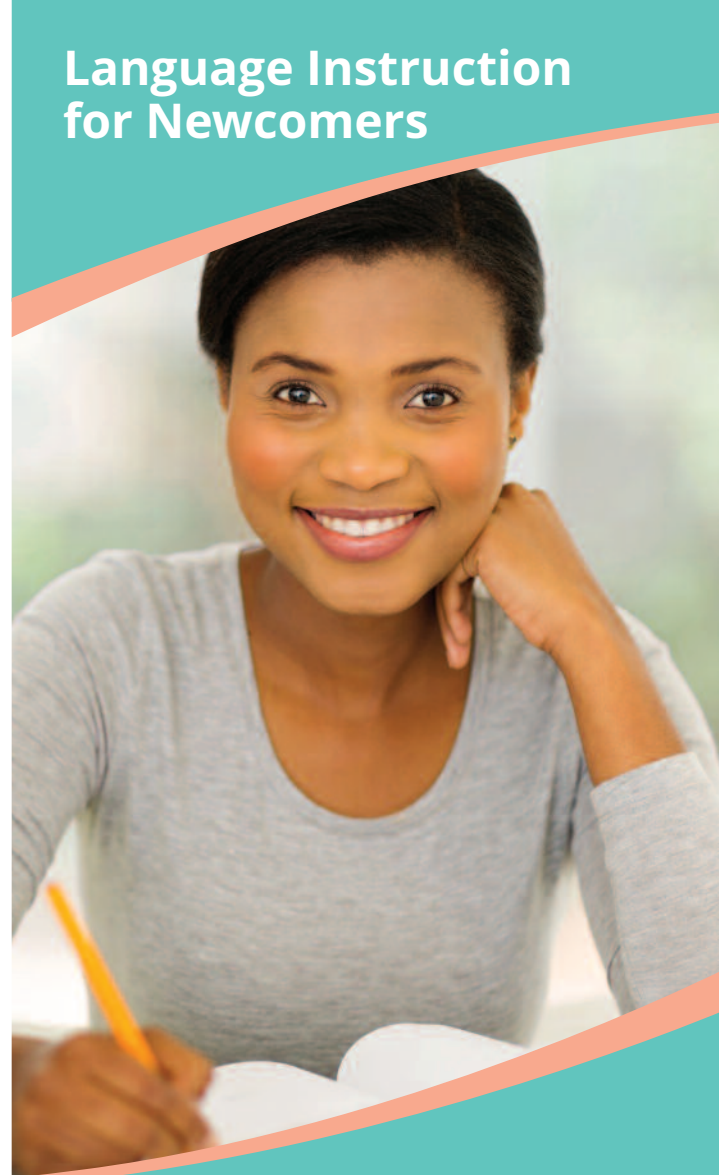
