SETTLEMENT-EMPLOYMENT WORKERS

- ◆ Provide one-on-one or group counseling for career planning, information and referral to professional associations and regulatory bodies
- ◆ Work closely with clients to set and meet employment goals

ONE-TO-ONE CASE MANAGEMENT

- ◆ Assess clients' needs and introduce them to available services
- ◆ Help clients access resources in the community
- ◆ Provide short-term and long-term career planning and guidance

WORKSHOPS

- ◆ Introduce clients to resume and cover letter writing
- ◆ Info on job search, interview skills, networking, hidden job markets, social media and more!
- ◆ Attendees must have LINC Level 6 or higher
