

**Position Title:** Contract Youth Facilitator (Expression! Program)

## Summary

NSMS is seeking an experienced, dynamic facilitator to deliver the Expression!, an art-based program for immigrant youth (aged 8-12) on a contract basis. Under the direction of the Youth Coordinator, the Youth Facilitator will be responsible for working within a team approach with a summer student to deliver/facilitate, and evaluate this program.

The program will consist of 5 sessions through July 9-13, 2018. Each session will be held from 1:00pm – 4:00pm at the North Shore Multicultural Society (NSMS).

Each day will include 5 working hours, including prep time, program time, clean up and dealing with any specific needs. There will be an additional 2 hours allocated for meeting time, for a total of 28 hours. The program will include activities designed to foster fun, confidence building, self-awareness and connection amongst participants, and support the settlement and integration process of immigrant youth.

## Qualifications:

- Degree, diploma, or certificate in community development, youth leadership, counselling or education, and/or an appropriate combination of experience and training
- Good working knowledge of immigrant youth barriers and challenges, social justice issues, diversity and anti-racism
- Demonstrated ability to work with key stakeholders including the supervisor, NSMS colleagues, participants, parents, and funders
- Demonstrated ability to adapt to the learning needs of English language learners
- Second language (Farsi/Mandarin/Cantonese an asset)
- Experience and/or training in facilitation of elementary youth groups, with experience in delivering art-based activities to spark communication and discussion
- Excellent interpersonal-communication skills, experienced in conflict resolution
- Experience in finding methods to overcome immigrant youth barriers/problem solving
- Demonstrated experience in youth involvement strategies and models
- Experience in working with 8-12 year old immigrant youth, specifically in the areas of settlement/integration
- Experience in one-on-one youth support an asset
