OUR SERVICES

SETTLEMENT-EMPLOYMENT WORKERS

- Provide one-on-one or group counseling for career planning, information and referral to professional associations and regulatory bodies
- Work closely with clients to set and meet employment goals

ONE-TO-ONE CASE MANAGEMENT

- Assess clients' needs and introduce them to available services
- Help clients access resources in the community
- Provide short-term and long-term career planning and guidance

WORKSHOPS

- Introduce clients to resume and cover letter writing
- Info on job search, interview skills, networking, hidden job markets, social media and more!
- Attendees must have LINC Level 6 or higher

JOB PLACEMENT SPECIALISTS

- Provide one-on-one support to clients who have completed workshops
- Help clients for effective job search
- Provide guidance and information on networking, events and job postings, and interview preparation
